REBELLION IN IRELAND.

DUBLIN, SEPT. 28.

DUBLIN CASTLE, SEPT. 28.

Extracts of Letters from Major General TRENCH to Captain TAYLOR, Private Secretary to his Excellency the LORD LIEUTENANT, dated Camp, near Killala, the 24th and 25th inst.

“SIR,—I have the honour to acquaint you, for the information of his Excellency the LORD LIEUTENANT, that, previous to my leaving Castlebar, on Saturday the 22nd inst., I had ordered Lord PORTARLINGTON, with the regiment under his command, 40 of the 24th Light Dragoons, Captain O'HARA'S, Captain WYNNE'S and Captain CROFTON'S Corps of Yeomanry, to meet me at Ballina at ten o'clock on Sunday morning, from Sligo. I also ordered the Armagh militia, consisting of above 300 men, under Major ACHESSON to proceed from Foxford and co-operate with me at the same hour. I marched with the Roxburgh Light Dragoons, 300 of the Downshire, the Kerry Regiment, the Prince of Wales's Fencibles, and two curricle guns, with the Tyrawley Cavalry, by the Barhague Road, and ordered Colonel FRASER with 300 of his regiment to march from Newport, where I had detached him on Friday, in order, if possible, to cut off the retreat of the Rebels. 
